...Jesus

"She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins." (Matthew 1:21)

...The Name Of Jesus Christ

"And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved." (Acts 4:12)

... Calling On The Name Of The Lord
"...for "whoever will call on the name of the Lord will be saved." (Romans 10:13), (Acts 2:21), (Joel 2:32a)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By...

...Belief

"They said, 'Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household." (Acts 16:31)

"For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who beholds the Son and believes in Him will have eternal life, and I Myself will raise him up on the last day." (Luke 6:40)

...Hope

"For in hope we have been saved, but hope that is seen is not hope; for who hopes for what he already sees?" (Romans 8:24)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By...

...His Grace

"For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God..." (Ephesians 2:8)

...His Mercy

"He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit..." (Titus 3:5)

...His Blood

"Much more then, having now been justified by **His blood**, we shall be saved from the wrath of God
through Him." (Romans 5:9)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By...

...His Life

"For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by **His life**." (Romans 5:10)

...The Gospel

"For I am not ashamed of **the gospel**, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also the Greek." (**Romans 1:16**)

"Now I make known to you, brethren, **the gospel** which I preached to you, which also you received, in which also you stand, by which also you are saved, if you hold fast the word which I preached to you, unless you believed in vain."

(1 Corinthians 15:1-2)

"In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, **the gospel** of your salvation, having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise..." **(Ephesians 1:13)**

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By...

...The Word

"Therefore, putting aside all filthiness and all that remains of wickedness, in humility receive **the word** implanted, which is able to save your souls." (James 1:21)

...Words

"...and he will speak words to you by which you will be saved, you and all your household." (Acts 11:14)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By...

...Obedience

"And having been made perfect, He became to all those who **obey** Him the source of eternal salvation." (**Hebrews 5:9**)

...Confession

"...that if you **confess** with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he **confesses**, resulting in salvation. (Romans 10:9-10)

"Therefore everyone who **confesses** Me before men, I will also confess him before My Father who is in heaven." (Matthew 10:32)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By...

...Repentance

"I tell you, no, but unless you **repent**, you will all likewise perish." (Luke 13:3)

"Peter said to them, 'Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." (Acts 2:38)

("the gift" = eternal life - Romans 6:23)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By...

...Baptism

"He who has believed and has been **baptized** shall be saved; but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned." (Mark 16:16)

"Corresponding to that, **baptism** now saves you not the removal of dirt from the flesh, but an appeal to God for a good conscience through the resurrection of Jesus Christ..." (1 Peter 3:21)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By...

...Baptism

"And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, 'All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, **baptizing** them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

(Matthew 28:18-20)

...Baptism

"Peter said to them, 'Repent, and each of you be **baptized** in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." (Acts 2:38)

"Now why do you delay? Get up and be **baptized**, and wash away your sins, calling on His name.

(Acts 22:16)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By...

...Forgiveness Of Sins

"To give to His people the knowledge of salvation by the **forgiveness** of their sins..." **(Luke 1:77)**

...Faith

(A "Living Faith," obediently practicing the works of God, not the works of man, nor the works of the Law of Moses, nor the works of the devil)

"For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them." (Ephesians 2:8-10)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By...

...Faith

"Therefore, having been justified by **faith**, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ..." (Romans 5:1)

"...to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by **faith** in Me." (Acts 26:18)

"For we maintain that a man is justified by **faith** apart from works of the Law." (Romans 3:28)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By...

...Faith

"Nevertheless knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the Law but through **faith** in Christ Jesus, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we may be justified by **faith** in Christ and not by the works of the Law; since by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified." (Galatians 2:16)

"Therefore they said to Him, 'What shall we do, so that we may work the works of God?' Jesus answered and said to them, 'This is the work of God, that you **believe** in Him whom He has sent.'" (John 6:28-29)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By... ... An Obedient Faith

"If you love Me, you will keep My commandments."
(John 14:15)

"By this we know that we have come to know Him, if we **keep His commandments**. The one who says, "I have come to know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him..." (1 John 2:34)

"So then, my beloved, just as you have always **obeyed**, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your salvation with fear and trembling..." (Philippians 2:12)

"Why do you call Me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say?" (Luke 6:46)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By...

There are many who teach that we are saved "by faith alone."

Do not be deceived by this lie.

This false doctrine is in direct opposition to the word of God.

"You see that a man is justified by works and **not by faith alone**."

(James 2:24)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By...

...A Working Faith

"What use is it, my brethren, if someone says he has faith but he has no works? Can that faith save him? If a brother or sister is without clothing and in need of daily food, and one of you says to them, 'Go in peace, be warmed and be filled,' and yet you do not give them what is necessary for their body, what use is that? Even so faith, if it has no works, is dead, being by itself. But someone may well say, 'You have faith and I have works; show me your faith without the works, and I will show you my faith by my works.' You believe that God is one. You do well; the demons also believe, and shudder. But are you willing to recognize, you foolish fellow, that faith without works is useless?" (James 2:14-20)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By...

...A Working Faith

"Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered up Isaac his son on the altar? You see that faith was working with his works, and as a result of the works, faith was perfected; and the Scripture was fulfilled which says, 'And Abraham believed God, and it was reckoned to him as righteousness,' and he was called the friend of God. You see that a man is justified by works and not by faith alone. In the same way, was not Rahab the harlot also justified by works when she received the messengers and sent them out by another way? For just as the body without the spirit is dead, so also faith without works is dead."

(James 2:21-26)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By... ...A Practiced Faith

"Little children, make sure no one deceives you; the one who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous; the one who practices sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil."

(1 John 3:7-8)

According To The Bible, We Are Saved By... ... A Practiced Faith

"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter. Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness."" (Matthew 7:21-23)
