- "To stretch to," to stretch the eyes & ears toward anything, to give consideration
- Attention: "to apply the mind or pay attention,"; "be attentive" (Webster)
  - Psalms 17:1 "Hear the right, O Jehovah, attend unto my cry; give ear unto my prayer, that goeth not out of feigned lips."
- · Being present to learn & participate.
- Attending worship is vital to our faith and a commentary on it.

# First Day Of The Week Acts 20:6-7

- Worshipping God with their brethren was important Acts 20:6 cf. Traveling...
  - -Planned for & anticipated Hebrews 10:24-25 (Psalms 122:1)
  - -Encouragement, joy & gladness

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- A singular interest to worship God on the first day of the week – Acts 20:7
  - Break bread 1 Corinthians 11:17-34; Note verse 30
  - Sing Ephesians 5:19; Colossians 3:16
  - To edify 1 Corinthians 14:26; Hebrews 10:23-27

- Opportunity to teach the gospel *Acts 20:7* 
  - -Daily attention Acts 2:46; 5:41-42

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### To Read God's Word Nehemiah 8:1-8

- Opportunity to learn the law *Acts 20:7* 
  - All the law to Israel *Joshua 8:34-35* 
    - Book of the law lost. 2 Kings 22:8ff
    - Would be a famine of God's word. Amos 4:12; 8:11ff
  - Attentive to the law Nehemiah 8:1-3

  - -Must be heresies 1 Corinthians 11:19
  - -False teachers will come 2 Peter 2:1ff; 1 John 4:1
  - -Warnings against drifting -Hebrews 2:1-3; Acts 20:29-30

#### **Hebrews 10:25**

 "not forsaking our own assembling together, as the custom of some is, but exhorting (one another); and so much the more, as ye see the day drawing nigh."

(Episunágœ), to gather together. The act of gathering or assembling together (2 Thessalonians 2:1 [cf. 1 Thessalonians 4:17]). Hebrews 10:25 does not merely denote the assembling for corporate worship as a solitary or occasional act, but as customary conduct. The prep. epí, must refer to Christ Himself as the one to whom this assembly was attached. Thus it would have the meaning of not betraying one's attachment to Jesus Christ and other believers, not avoiding one's own personal responsibility as part of the body of Christ. (from The Complete Word Study Dictionary: New Testament)

"Forsaking" - egkataleipo (eng-kat-ali'-po); to leave behind in some place,
i.e. (in a good sense) let remain over,
or (in a bad sense) to desert: (Strongs)

"to abandon, i. e. to leave in
straits, leave helpless, to desert,
forsake...Hebrews 10:25"

(Thayer)

"Assembling together" episunagoge (ep-ee-soon-ag-o-gay');
a complete collection; especially a
Christian meeting (for worship)
(Strongs)
(the religious) assembly (of Christians):
Hebrews 10:25. (Thayer)

"Exhorting" - parakaleo (par-ak-al-eh'-o); to
cause someone to be encouraged or consoled,
either by verbal or non-verbal means – "to
encourage, to console, encouragement."
