# Definition

•<u>Baptize</u> (*baptizo*): "dip, submerge, immerse" cf. Luke 16:24

"... used among the Greeks to signify the dyeing of a garment, or the drawing of water by dipping a vessel into another ..." (Vine)

- Requires "much water" John 3:23
- A burial *Colossians 2:12*
- Going down into & coming up out of water *Acts 8:38-39*

# Common View:

"There are two baptisms whose necessity is taught by the Christian religion – baptism by <u>water</u>, and by the <u>Holy Ghost</u>: the first of which is an emblem of the second." (Albert Barnes, <u>Notes on the New Testament</u>, *Hebrews 6:2*) Israel Baptized Into Moses In The Cloud & Sea 1 *Corinthians 10:1-2; Exodus 14:19-22* 

- Relationship formed
- Follow His authority
- Separation from bondage

## **Baptism Of John**

- John the first to preach baptism. Mark 1:4-5
- Repentance must come first. Luke 3:8; Matthew 3:8-11
- *"For remission of sins."* Luke 3:2-3; Matthew 3:13
  People confessed their sins not that their sins were forgiven. Mark 1:4-5
  - Why was Jesus baptized? Matthew 3:13-17
- Authorized by God. Matthew 21:23-27; cf. John 1:19ff, 33
- Make ready a people. Luke 1:16-17
- Preparatory. Luke 3:3-6; (Luke 1:17); Acts 18:25-26; Acts 19:4

## Baptism Of Suffering – Mark 10:35-40

- •Christ's suffering. *Mark 10:32-34 (Luke 12:50)*
- •Apostles shared in this baptism. *Mark 10:39; 1 Corinthians 4:9-13; 2 Corinthians 1:8ff; 11:23ff*
- •Christians are willing to suffer for righteousness. *1 Peter 3:14; 4:14-16*

# Baptism For The Dead *1 Corinthians 15:29*

- •On account of the dead (ones). 15:13, 15-16, 18-20
- •Affirming resurrection, not proxy baptism. 15:29-34
  - •This is clearly against the meaning of Hebrews 9:27 and Luke 16:25-26.

# Baptism With Fire Matthew 3:11

- •Judgment / punishment. Matthew 5:22; Mark 9:43-50
- •Fruitless trees & chaff. Matthew 3:10, 12; 25:41; Revelation 20:14-15; 21:8

# Holy Spirit Baptism and Great Commission Baptism

## Holy Spirit Baptism

 Administered by Christ - Mark 1:7-8; John 1:33; Acts 1:5; 2:32-33

•Promise to apostles - John 16:12-14; Luke 24:48-49; Acts 1:1-5, 8

#### <u>G. Comm. Baptism</u>

- Administered by men
  Matthew 28:19; Acts
  8:38; 1 Corinthians 1:
  13-17
- •A command to all who believe - *Mark* 16:15-16; Acts 2:38; 8:37; 10:48

# Holy Spirit Baptism and Great Commission Baptism

#### Holy Spirit Baptism

- A promise to be received - *Luke 24:* 49; Acts 1:4-5, 8
- •Accompanied by miracles – Acts 2:1-4; 10:44-46

#### G. Comm. Baptism

- A command to be obeyed - Acts 10: 48; Romans 6:17
- •Not accompanied by miracles – Acts 8:12-17

# Holy Spirit Baptism and Great Commission Baptism

#### Holy Spirit Baptism

- For revelation (John 14:26; 16:13) & confirmation (Acts 11:15-18; 15:6-9)
- •Ceased in first century *(Ephesians* 4:5)
- G. Comm. Baptism
- For salvation (Mark 16:15-16; Acts 2:38; 22:16; 1 Peter 3:21)
- •Continues until Christ returns – (Matthew 28:18-20)
