Lessons On Prejudice

The Gospel is universal.

- Peter should have already understood this principle.
 - Prophecies. Isa. 2:2-4; Joel 2; cf. Acts 2
 - Christ's personal ministry. John 10:16; cf. Eph. 2:14
 - Great Commission. Mt. 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-16; Luke 24:47
 - Part of the last message to the apostles. Acts 1:8
 - Peter had understood it. Acts 2:39

- All the apostles should have already understood this for the same reasons.
- YET, they challenged Peter Acts 11:1ff; cf. Acts 11:12; 15:7ff; Galatians 2:11-12

- In Christ we are not to make distinctions among people. Galatians 3:28
- Christ died to remove barriers. Eph. 2:11-15
- Paul taught against such distinctions. Phil. 3:2-8
- James taught no social distinctions. James 2:1-5

- Devout" Verse 2
- Had a reverent family. Verse 2
- Charitable. "gave alms" Verse 2
- Prayed always. Verse 2
- Just and good report. (KJV) Verse 22

- Desired to know. Acts 10:33
 - Morality cannot remove sin
 - It is necessary *Ephesians* 5:3-11; *1 Peter* 2:11-12



Miracle #1

 - Cornelius praying. cf. 1 Pet. 3:12
 Memorial cf. Gen. 3:15; 12:1-3
 - Told Cornelius what to do. Verse 6
 Acts 11:14; Titus 3:5

Miracle #2

- Peter's vision. Verses 9-16
 - Men on way to Joppa. Vs. 7-9
 - Had preached only to Jews. Vision convinced him to go. Verses 11-16

Miracle # 3

- Spirit assists in same matter. Vs. 19-20
- Peter goes with six brethren. Vs. 23; 11:12

• Meeting at home of Cornelius.

- Peter refuses to be worshipped. Verses 25-26
- Cornelius relates his experience. Verses 30-32
- Many present "to hear all things commanded." Verse 33

■ Peter's sermon. Verses 34-43.

1. No partiality with God.

- Must fear God. cf. Eccl. 12:13; Heb. 10:31; Rom. 11:22; 2 Cor. 5:11; 1 Peter 2:17 "Honor all men. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the king."
- Work righteousness. *Ps* 119:172 "Let *my tongue sing of thy word; for all thy commandments are righteousness.*" *cf. Rom.* 10:1-10
