Security Of Those Who Trust In The Lord ...

Psalms 37:35-36, "I have seen the wicked in great power, and spreading himself like a green tree in its native soil. But one passed by, and, lo, he was not: yea, I sought him, but he could not be found."

- ☐ The wicked seem to prosper.
- ☐ They are not in trouble as other men.
- □ Jeremiah 12:1, "... wherefore doth the way of the wicked prosper? wherefore are all they at ease that deal very treacherously?"
- \Box This was Asaph's dilemma. (Psalms 73:3-12, 18-19)

Security Of Those Who Trust In The Lord ...

Psalms 37:35-36, "I have seen the wicked in great power, and spreading himself like a green tree in its native soil. <u>But one passed by, and, lo, he was not: yea, I sought him, but he could not be found.</u>"

- □ Their disappearance is just as manifest as their prosperity had been (verse 35). Think of the immense prosperity of Old Testament Babylon, "that golden city" (Isaiah 14:4; Isaiah 13:19).
- □ Think of the immense prosperity of New Testament Babylon
- □ Where is the Old Testament Babylon now, with all its rich and powerful people? Vanished as completely as Sodom and Gomorrah (Isaiah 13:19; Jeremiah 50:39-40).
- □ NOTE: New Testament Babylon. Revelation 18:16-21

Security Of Those Who Trust In The Lord ...

Psalms 37:37-38, "Mark the perfect man, and behold the upright; for there is a (happy) end to the man of peace. As for transgressors, they shall be destroyed together; the end of the wicked shall be cut off."

- $\hfill\Box$ The Transgressors/Wicked:
 - With all its power and prosperity (verse 35), the life of the wicked may seem attractive; until you consider their end (Psalms 73:17; cf. 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9).
- ☐ The Perfect/Upright: (Job 1:1, 8; 2:3)
 - Will be saved and delivered (verses 39-40) and will dwell in the land forever (verse 29).
 - His seed will be blessed (verse 26).
- □ Numbers 23:10, "Let me die the death of the righteous, And let my last end be like his!"

Security Of Those Who Trust In The Lord ...

Psalms 37:39-40, "But the <u>salvation of the righteous</u> is of Jehovah; He is their stronghold in the time of trouble. And Jehovah <u>helpeth</u> them, and <u>rescueth</u> them; He rescueth them from the wicked, and saveth them, because they have taken refuge in him."

- □ NOTE: The righteous will certainly face times of trouble. (cf. Psalms 34, especially verses 18-19)
- ☐ However, the Lord will always be their strength (Psalms 27:1; 31:2, 4) and will always provide them with salvation.
- □ The Lord will deliver them from the wicked who are seeking to oppose them (verses 12, 14, 32).

Security Of Those Who Trust In The Lord ...

Psalms 37:39-40, "But the salvation of the righteous is of Jehovah; He is their stronghold in the time of trouble. And Jehovah helpeth them, and rescueth them; He rescueth them from the wicked, and saveth them, <u>because</u> they have taken refuge in him."

- NOTE: The element of TRUST.
 - Those who are strong in the Lord have put on the armor of God. (Ephesians 6:10, 13)
 - NOTE WHY: 1 John 2:12-14
 - □ "Your sins are forgiven"
 - □ "You know Him"
 - □ "You overcome the wicked one"
 - □ "You are strong"
 - □ "The word of God abideth in you"
 - NOTE WHY: "because greater is he that is in you, than he that iş in the world" (1 John 4:4).
