 - All 22 letters of the Hebrew alphabet are used as the first character in each section
 - In verses 1-9 the sections are:
 - □ Aleph Verses 1-2, "Fret not ..."
 - □ Beth Verses 3-4, "Trust ... Delight ..."
 - □ Gimel Verses 5-6, "Commit ..."
 - □ Daleth Verse 7, "Be still ... wait patiently ..."
 - ☐ He Verses 8-9, "Refrain from anger ..."

Introduction

- ☐ The nine acrostic psalms:
 - **9**, 10, 25, 34, 37, 111, 112, 119, 145
- ☐ There are acrostics also in:
 - Proverbs 31:10-31
 - Lamentations
 - Nahum 1:2-8
- □ Why acrostics?
 - Perhaps a sense of completeness (i.e. A to Z)
 - Perhaps to assist in memorization

Aleph – Verses 1-2

- □ "Fret not ..."
 - "Burn with vexation"
 - "Be incensed"
 - God's anger
 - □ "... speak to them in his wrath ..." (Psalms 2:4-6)
 - □ "... because he was angry." (Psalms 18:7)
 - Anger of the unrighteous
 - □ "... their anger was kindled against us" (Psalms 124:1-3)

Aleph – Verses 1-2

- □ "... they will soon fade ..."
 - "... they are doomed to destruction ..." (Psalms 92:7-8)
 - "... destroyed in a moment" (Psalms 73:19)
 - See also: Verses 9-10, 15, 17, 20, 28, 36, 38

Beth - Verses 3-4

- □ "Trust in the Lord ..."
 - "... put their trust in you ..." (Psalms 9:10)
 - "Blessed is the man ..." (Psalms 40:4)
 - "Cast your burden on the Lord ..." (Psalms 55:22-23)
 - "The Lord is on my side ..." (Psalms 118:6)
 - □ cf. Hebrews 13:6, "So we can confidently say ..."

Beth – Verses 3-4

- □ "Delight yourself in the Lord ..."
 - "... you shall take delight in the Lord" (Isaiah 58:13-14)
 - "... abide in me" (John 15:7-8)

Gimel – Verses 5-6

- □ "Commit your way to the Lord"
 - "Humble yourselves ..." (I Peter 5:6-7)
 - "Commit your work to the Lord" (Proverbs 16:1-3)
 - "... this is the whole of man" (Ecclesiastes 12:13)

Gimel – Verses 5-6

- □ "... righteousness ..."
 - "... counted it to him as righteousness" (Genesis 15:6)
 - "... the righteous holds to his way" (Job 17:9)
- □ "... justice ..."
 - "my justice was like a robe ..." (Job 29:14)
 - "I have done what is just ..." (Psalms 119:121)

Daleth – Verse 7

- □ "Be still ... wait patiently ..."
 - "... wait quietly for the salvation ..." (Lamentations 3:25-26)
 - "... Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalms 46:10-11)
- □ Compare Mark 4:39, "Peace! Be still!"

He – Verses 8-9

- □ "Refrain from anger ... wrath"
 - "... wrath and anger ... be put away" (Ephesians 4:31-32)
 - "... put them all away: anger, wrath ..." (Colossians 3:8-10)
