THE REVELATION OF GOD'S MIND — Psalms 19:7-9.
Respect For God Is Seen In How Or Whether We
Respect His Word — Psalms 19:7-9.

- ➤ <u>Law</u> The standard (rule) we must submit to (Matthew 28:18; 17:5; Colossians 3:17).
 - > It is upright and whole (perfect), converting the soul.
- ➤ <u>Testimony</u> Pronouncements (declarations, attestations) of God are certain (cf. Psalms 110:4) and give wisdom to the simple.
- <u>Statutes</u> Precepts, appointments of God are right (fitting, proper, straight, upright) and rejoice the heart of the upright – John 3:19-21.

THE REVELATION OF GOD'S MIND – Psalms 19:7-9.
Respect For God Is Seen In How Or Whether We
Respect His Word – Psalms 19:7-9.

- <u>Commandments</u> (directives) are pure Light our way – Psalms 119:105.
- Fear (reverence) of God proceeds from hearing His word, which is altogether holy – Exodus 3:4-6; Psalms 119:38.
- Judgments (ordinances, measurements) are completely true (established, faithful) and righteous (upright) – "thus saith the Lord!" – John 12:48-50.

MAN'S PROPER RESPONSE TO GOD'S REVELATION - Psalms 19:10-14.

- ➤ <u>Desire God's Words</u> 19:10. "More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and the droppings of the honeycomb."
 - Value them, treasure them, honor them Psalms 119:127.
- ➤ Accept The Warnings Of God's Word 19:11.
- ➤ Obey Them And Be Rewarded 19:11; Hebrews 5:8-9.

MAN'S PROPER RESPONSE TO GOD'S REVELATION – Psalms 19:10-14.

- Use Them To Be Saved From Sin 19:12-13 (cf. 2 Timothy 3:16; John 8:31-32; Romans 1:16-17).
 - 19:12 God's word can cleanse us from sins which are concealed to others. We know our errors as God's word teaches us of them Hebrews 4:12-13.
 - 19:13 God's word can guard us against and restrain us from self-willed sins. (i.e., rebellion – Deuteronomy 1:43)
 - 19:13 When God's word rules over us, sin will not!

Psalms 119:11, "Thy word have I laid up in my heart, that I might not sin against thee."

MAN'S PROPER RESPONSE TO GOD'S REVELATION – Psalms 19:10-14.

- ➤ Our Words and Thoughts Must Agree With God's Perfect Revelation 19:14; Psalms 55:15.
 - Our words and thoughts will only be acceptable if they agree with divine truth! (cf. Acts 26:9) cf. Matthew 12:34-37; 15:18-19
 - Only then, we find divine acceptance (2 Timothy 2:15).
 - Only then, we are redeemed. Psalms 31:5, "Into thy hand I commend my spirit: <u>Thou hast</u> <u>redeemed me</u>, O Jehovah, thou God of truth."

A Call To Praise God In Song (1-3)

- The beauty of praise This psalm emphasizes WHY He is worthy of praise. cf. Acts 2:47
- Hebrews 13:15, "Offer up a sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of lips which make confession to his name."
- Verses 2-3 David speaks of praising God both with our songs and instruments of music.
 - Does this justify the use of instruments today? NO!
- It is obvious that David wrote under the Old Law (2 Chronicles 29:25), which was nailed to the cross

 Colossians 2:14; cf. Ephesians 5:19 and thus the things they did under that law do not apply to us today.
