The Righteous person Psalms 15

Psalms 15:2-5

2 He that walketh uprightly, and worketh righteousness, and speaketh truth in his heart;

3 He that slandereth not with his tongue, nor doeth evil to his friend, nor taketh up a reproach against his neighbor:

4 In whose eyes a reprobate is despised, but who honoreth them that fear Jehovah; He that sweareth to his own hurt, and changeth not;

5 He that putteth not out his money to interest, nor taketh reward against the innocent. He that doeth these things shall never be moved.

Stated Positively Psalms 15:2, 4

- Walks uprightly. (2)
- 2. Works righteousness. (2)
- 3. Speaks truth in his heart. (2)
- 4. Despises sin and honors reverence. (4)
- 5. Keeps his word. (4)

The Righteous person Psalms 15

The Righteous person Psalms 15

Stated Negatively Psalms 15:3, 5

- Does not backbite (3); Romans 1:30;
 2 Corinthians 12:19-21; 1 Peter 2:1
- This word is applied to those who walk around as spies (Genesis 42:11; 2 Samuel 10:3).
- Does not do evil to neighbor (3)
 Proverbs 24:29; Matthew 7:12
 - In this respect also, they are doing what their Master has done (1 Peter 2:19-23).

The Righteous person Psalms 15

Stated Negatively Psalms 15:3, 5

- Does not spread damaging reports of a friend (3)
 - Gives benefit of doubt. 1 Corinthians 13:5
 - Does not destroy others. James 5:8-9
 - Not a whisperer. Romans 1:29
 - Not a talebearer. Proverbs 20:19; 26:20-21

The Righteous person Psalms 15

Stated Negatively Psalms 15:3, 5

- **Does not take advantage of others** (5) [Usury]
- The Israelites were permitted to "lend upon usury" to a foreigner (Deuteronomy 23:20), as long as they did not wrong him or oppress him in any way (Exodus 22:21ff; 23:9; "thou shalt love him as thyself," Leviticus 19:33-34).
- But from their fellow Israelites, they were not permitted to take any kind of usury. Even that which could lawfully be taken from a foreigner (Deuteronomy 23:19-20; Exodus 22:25; Leviticus 25:36-37).
- NOTE: Nehemiah 5 (usury)

The Righteous person Psalms 15

Stated Negatively Psalms 15:3, 5

- Does not profit by harming the innocent (5)
 - Refuses bribes. Isaiah 1:23; 5:23; Jeremiah 22:17; Ezekiel 22:12
 - NOTE: Judas Iscariot. Matthew 26:15; 27:3-5

The Righteous

- o Blessed by God. Psalms 5:12
- o "He who does these things shall never be moved" (Psalms 15:5)
- He has built his house upon the rock. Matthew 7:24-27
- Calling and election sure.2 Peter 1:10-11
