# The Righteous person Psalms 15

Psalms 15:1, "Jehovah, who shall sojourn in thy tabernacle? Who shall dwell in thy holy hill?"

- Character of integrity and holiness.
- Question asked. 15:1
  - Only certain people will dwell in that place with Him (Psalms 61:4; Revelation 21:3; 7:15; John 14:2-3, 23).
- Ouestion answered. 15:2-5

# The Righteous person Psalms 15

Psalms 15:2-5

2 He that walketh uprightly, and worketh righteousness, and speaketh truth in his heart;

3 He that slandereth not with his tongue, nor doeth evil to his friend, nor taketh up a reproach against his neighbor;

4 In whose eyes a reprobate is despised, but who honoreth them that fear Jehovah; He that sweareth to his own hurt, and changeth not;

5 He that putteth not out his money to interest, nor taketh reward against the innocent. He that doeth these things shall never be moved.

# The Righteous person Psalms 15

### **Stated Positively**

Psalms 15:2, 4

- Walks uprightly (2)
  - Anyone who claims to abide in the Lord "ought ... to walk even as he walked" (1 John 2:6), without blemish (1 Peter 2:21-23; 1:19).
  - Walks in God's truth. Psalms 26:3
  - Guided by God's wisdom.
    Psalms 1:1-2; Proverbs 2:1-15; 4:5-9;
    Colossians 2:3

### The Righteous person Psalms 15

### **Stated Positively**

Psalms 15:2, 4

#### Works righteousness (2);

- 1 Timothy 6:11; 2 Timothy 2:22; 3:16-17
- Sincere intent. Hebrews 13:18
- Not hypocritical. Isaiah 33:14-16
- cf. the character of Cornelius. Acts 10:1-3, 22, 34ff
- 1 John 2:29, "If ye know that he is righteous, ye know that every one also that doeth righteousness is begotten of him."
- 1 John 3:10, "In this the children of God are manifest," and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God ..."

# The Righteous person Psalms 15

### **Stated Positively**

Psalms 15:2, 4

- Speaks truth in his heart (2)
  - Consistent character. Psalms 101:6-7
  - Thoughts translate into character. Philippians 4:8
  - Matthew 12:34, "Ye offspring of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh." (cf. Matthew 23:26)
- Ephesians 4:25

#### The Righteous person Psalms 15

#### Stated Positively Psalms 15:2, 4

- O Despises sin and honors reverence (4) Psalms 24:3-5; Romans 1:32
  - Rejects evil people. Psalms 26:5
  - Honors who fears God. 3 John 5-8
  - He does not praise the despicable and despise the praiseworthy (cf. Isaiah 5:20; Proverbs 17:15).
  - On the contrary, he despises and rejects the sort of person who ought to be despised and rejected.
  - Deuteronomy 25:1, "If there be a controversy between men, and they come unto judgment, and (the judges) judge them; then they shall justify the righteous, and condemn the wicked"

### The Righteous person Psalms 15

#### **Stated Positively** Psalms 15:2, 4

- - Israel and Gibeonites. Joshua 9:18-19; cf. Numbers 30:2
  - The integrity of our word must be stronger than self-preservation. Matthew 5:33-37; James 5:12

#### Stated Negatively Psalms 15:3, 5

- Does not backbite (3); Romans 1:30;
  - 2 Corinthians 12:19-21; 1 Peter 2:1
- o This word is applied to those who walk around as spies (Genesis 42:11; 2 Samuel 10:3).
- Does not do evil to neighbor (3) Proverbs 24:29; Matthew 7:12

• In this respect also, they are doing what their

Master has done (1 Peter 2:19-23).

### Stated Negatively Psalms 15:3, 5

#### Does not spread damaging reports of a friend (3)

- Gives benefit of doubt. 1 Corinthians 13:5
- Does not destroy others. James 5:8-9
- Not a whisperer. Romans 1:29
- Not a talebearer. Proverbs 20:19; 26:20-21
