Psalms 2

Four Scenes:

Scene 1: Man's Rebellion (1-3)

• People will not overthrow God's purposes, so the faithful trust in the Lord.

Psalms 2:1-3, "Why do the nations <u>rage</u>, and the peoples meditate a <u>vain thing</u>? The kings of the earth <u>set themselves</u>, and the rulers <u>take counsel</u> together, <u>against Jehovah</u>, and <u>against his anointed</u>, (saying), Let us break <u>their</u> bonds asunder, and cast away <u>their</u> cords from us."

- The Psalmist clearly indicates in these opening rhetorical questions that their <u>plotting</u> and <u>scheming</u> are a <u>vain thing</u> (riq – reek). A single word that means a worthless thing; to no purpose; empty.
- Psalms 94:16-19
 - The gospel versus the wisdom of men.
 - $1\ Corinthians\ 1{:}18{-}25$
 - False doctrines versus truth. John 8:31-32

Scene 2: God's Reply (4-6)

• Men's corrupt laws hasten God's day of wrath.

Psalms 2:4-5, "He that sitteth in the heavens will laugh: the Lord will have them in derision. <u>Then will he speak unto them in his wrath, and vex them in his sore displeasure.</u>"

- READ: Psalms 94:20-23
 - Calls to repent and return.
 - Judgment.
 - Jerusalem. Isaiah 1:21-26; Matthew 23:38
 - •Rome. Revelation 19:15-21
 - America? Romans 2:1-3 (1:18-32)

Scene 2: God's Reply (4-6)

• Men's corrupt laws hasten God's day of wrath.

Psalms 2:4-5, "He that sitteth in the heavens will laugh: (cf. Ezekiel 18:23, 32) the Lord will have them in derision. <u>Then will he speak unto them in his wrath, and vex them in his sore displeasure."</u>

- God is sovereign His will and purposes cannot be thwarted (Psalms 11:4; 37:13; 68:33; 115:3; Isaiah 40:22; 57:15; 66:1; Acts 5:38-39; Galatians 6:7-9; Jude 18; 2 Peter 3:3-10).
- Historically all who have rejected God's will have perished (Genesis 6-7; Exodus 14:27-31;
 2 Peter 2:4-8; 3:6-8; Matthew 24)

Scene 2: God's Reply (4-6)

• Men's corrupt laws hasten God's day of wrath.

Psalms 2:4-5, "He that sitteth in the heavens will laugh: the Lord will have them in derision. <u>Then will he speak unto them in his wrath, and vex them in his sore displeasure.</u>"

- The atheist / humanist. Psalms 14:1; 53:1; Romans 1:28
- The immoral / ungodly. Romans 1:18-32;
 1 Corinthians 6:9-10; Galatians 5:19-21; Revelation 21:8
- False teachers / deceived. 2 Peter 2:18-20; 2 Thessalonians 2:10-12
- Those rejecting His authority. Matthew 7:21-23; 2 John 9; Jude 8

Scene 2: God's Reply (4-6)

• Jesus Christ rules as King over friend and foe.

Psalms 2:6, "Yet I have set my king upon my holy hill of Zion."

- Psalms 110:1-3
- Despite man's attempt to withstand God's purpose, He would "set" (coronate / crown / install) His King in Zion. (Daniel 2:44-45; Matthew 16:18; Matthew 28:18; Joel 2:32; Galatians 4:26; Hebrews 12:22; Philippians 3:20; Revelation 3:12; 21:2, 10)

Acts 4:23-31

- "Thou art my Son!" (Matthew 3:17; 8:29; 16:16; 17:5; Acts 8:37; 13:33; Romans 1:4. Hebrews 1:5; 3:6; 5:5, 8)
- His complete authority demands our allegiance. Luke 6:46
- Bible authority is Christ's authority. Colossians 3:17

• God has revealed His plan!

- "This day I have begotten thee" (Refers to the resurrection of Christ in the NT). Hebrews 1:5
- Raised to sit on David's throne. Acts 2:30-36; 13:33-37
- Declared to be the Son of God with power by the resurrection.
 Romans 1:4
- Raised to be our High Priest. Hebrews 5:5; 6:20; Ps. 110:4

- Jesus Is, NOW, Lord of lords and King of kings. Matthew 28:18; Acts 10:36; 1 Timothy 6:15; Ephesians 1:20-23; Colossians 1:18

- Jesus is also judge ... all who reject His authority will be completely and irreparably destroyed.
- All judgment committed to the Son. John 5:22-23; 12:48
- Jesus will judge the living and dead. Acts 10:42; 17:30-31
- All must stand before Him. 2 Corinthians 5:10; 2 Peter 3:7;
 Jude 14-15

 (Eastern cults / Islam / Judaism /
 Catholicism / Denominationalism)
- Rejection of Christ's authority (over emphasis on grace / ridiculing "precision obedience" / charge of legalism)

Scene 4: Admonition (10-12)

Behold the goodness and the severity of God.

Psalms 2:9-11, "Thou shalt break them with a rod of iron; Thou shalt dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel. <u>Now therefore</u> be wise, O ye kings: be instructed, ye judges of the earth. <u>Serve Jehovah with fear, and rejoice with trembling.</u>"

- •cf. Romans. 11:22
 - Salvation and judgment.
 - •Life and condemnation. John 5:26-27, 30

Scene 4: Admonition (10-12)

Let us serve the Lord with fear and rejoice with trembling. (Invitation)

Psalms 2:10-11, "Now therefore <u>be wise</u>, O ye kings: <u>be instructed</u>, ye judges of the earth. <u>Serve Jehovah with fear, and rejoice with trembling</u>."

- Hebrews 12:28-29
- Transform our mind. "be wise, be instructed." Hosea 14:9; Romans 12:1-2
- Yield our will. "Serve Jehovah with fear." Philippians 2:12; Hebrews 4:1; 12:28-29
- Govern our attitude. "rejoice with trembling." Acts 5:41; 16:25; Philippians 4:4; James 1:2; Romans 5:2-3; 1 Peter 4:13
- Devoted service from hearts of reverent faith. 2 Corinthians 5:7
- Humble worship in spirit and truth. John 4:24



Scene 4: Admonition (10-12)

Our trust in the Lord's rule is greater than our trust in man's rule.

Psalms 2:9-11, "Thou shalt break them with a rod of iron; Thou shalt dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel. Now therefore be wise, <u>O ye kings: be instructed</u>, ye judges of the earth. Serve Jehovah with <u>fear</u>, and rejoice with <u>trembling</u>."

- Jeremiah 17:5; Proverbs 3:5-6
 - •Remember which King has our first allegiance! Matthew 6:33

Scene 4: Admonition (10-12)

God's Son Rules Today!

Psalms 2:12, "<u>Kiss the son</u>, lest he be angry, and ye perish in the way, for his wrath will soon be kindled. <u>Blessed are all they that take refuge in him</u>."

- Nations rise and fall on righteousness.
 - Proverbs 14:34, "Righteousness exalteth a nation; But sin is a reproach to any people."
- Judgment begins in the house of God.
 1 Peter 4:16-19
- God's Son reigns!
 - Blesses the faithful.
 - Punishes the rebellious.
