#### Context

- 1 Thessalonians 4:1-8
  - Abound more and more (4:1)
  - "the will of God, your sanctification ..." (4:3)
    - To be different from the world and people around them.
    - Set apart to be pleasing and useful to God.
    - Entails:
      - Avoid sexual immorality, avoiding "passion of lust," not to take advantage of their brethren.

- 1 Thessalonians 4:9-12
  - But concerning <u>brotherly love (Greek: philadelphia)</u>
    you have no need that I should write to you ...
  - 2 John 5-6 | All are taught by God
  - 1 Corinthians 6:1-2, 5-8
    - Some still require the reminder
- 1 Thessalonians 4:10
  - Increase more and more
  - Ephesians 4:11-16
    - The need to grow in truth and love ... for the edifying of itself in love.
