Matthew 28:19–20 "Go ye therefore, and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit: teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I commanded you: and lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world." cf. Mark 16:15; Luke 24:44ff "All nations"

"Go Make Disciples"

- Responsibility of the teacher:
 - To the message.
 - Know the urgency of the message. Romans 9:1; 10:1ff

• Responsibility of the taught:

- To the message.
- To know the urgency of the message. "What must I do?" Acts 2; 9; 16

"Go Make Disciples"

Definition: "Disciple."

- matheteuo to be a disciple or follower of another's doctrine (Matthew 27:57); to make a disciple (Matthew 28:19; Acts 14:21); to instruct (Matthew 13:52) with the purpose of making a disciple.
- matheteuo means not only to learn, but to become attached to one's teacher and to become his follower in doctrine and conduct of life. (The Complete Word Study Dictionary)

The Goal Of Discipleship.

 Stated by Jesus himself: to be like the teacher. Luke 6:40; cf. Romans 8:29; Galatians 4:19

Identifying Marks Of Discipleship

What Is A Disciple?

- One who abides in the words of Jesus. John 8:31; Matthew 7:21ff; James 1:21-25
- One who loves the brethren. John 13:34–35
- One who bears much fruit.
 John 15:5, 8; cf. Matthew 5:13-16

The Costs Of Discipleship

What Is A Disciple?

- Jesus must come first. Luke 14:26
- Before family. Matthew 10:34-37
- Before self. Luke 9:23-25
- Must be willing to suffer. Luke 14:27; 2 Timothy 3:12
- Renounce all that we have to follow Jesus. Luke 14:33; cf. John 6

God calls the lost through teaching. John 6:44–45; Romans 10:8–13, 14–17; **Note**: Acts 16:9–10

Make Disciples by Gospel Preaching. Acts 2:14, 22, 36, 40

Preaching saves believers. Corinthians 1:21; Romans 10:14-17

The Beginning Of Discipleship "<u>Go make disciples</u>." **TEACH**

- Choice of masters. (disciple).
 Acts 11:26, 21 ("Lord"), 23.
- Choice of conduct. cf. 1 Peter 4:1–5.
- Repentance Must Occur. Acts 11:18.
- Radical change in life because:
 - Die to sin. Galatians 2:20.

Choice. cf. Romans 6:16-18

The Beginning Of Discipleship

TEACH - Disciples are not made by the gospels of men:

- 1. <u>Social gospel</u>: Converted to recreation and social activities.
- Ecumenical gospel: Unity in moral and doctrinal diversity is sin (Galatians 1:8-9; 2 John 9-11).
- 3. <u>Denominational gospels</u>: Faith only, universalism, etc.
- 4. <u>Latter-day gospels</u>: LDS, JW's, Adventists, Premillennial, etc.

The Beginning Of Discipleship

"Go make disciples." BAPTIZE

- Water baptism is essential:
- For a relationship with God. Matthew 28:19 (Galatians 3:27)
- For salvation. Mark 16:16 (1 Peter 3:21)
- For remission of sins. Acts 2:38
- For cleansing. Acts 22:16
- Eor new life in Christ. Romans 6:3-4

The Beginning Of Discipleship

"Go make disciples." TEACHING THEM

- Bible teaching and learning is to a new Christian what milk is to a new baby.
 Peter 2:2; cf. Acts 2:41, 46; 5:12, 42
- God measures spiritual strength and maturity by our interest in, our commitment to and our growth in learning and living God's word. Hebrews 5:11-12.

- One who **abides** in His word.
- One who **loves** the brethren.
