## Fruits of Repentance "For behold ..." 2 Corinthians 7:11 - Indignation - Enraged over sin. cf. Genesis 39:9 • All sin is against God. 2 Samuel 12:9,14; Psalms 51:1-4; Luke 22:61-62 - Fear - Dread of not pleasing God. cf. 1 Corinthians 5:6 NOTE: 2 Corinthians 5:11 - Sin has consequences.

# Fruits of Repentance "For behold ..." 2 Corinthians 7:11 - Longing - Earnest desire to do and be right. cf. 2 Corinthians 7:7; Luke 15:1-2,17-18 - Zea/ - Fervent spirit, not apathetic neglect. • Eager to help others. Romans 9:1-3; 10:1ff

#### Fruits of Repentance "For behold ..." 2 Corinthians 7:11 - Avenging - Sin no longer tolerated - Revenge not taught. (Romans 12:17-19) - 1 Corinthians 5; cf. 2 Corinthians 2:6 - Approved yourselves to be pure - Pure in the matter, free from blame.
