

Jesus was not a crowdpleaser (Lk. 14:25-27)

- His teaching did not change in order to hold on to followers. Jno. 6:60-62, 66
- Demanded that people count the cost and pay the price without excuses.
 - Excuses not accepted. Lk. 14:15-20, 24
 - Forsake all to be a disciple. Lk. 14:33

Counting the Cost of Discipleship (Lk. 14:28-32)

- COST: Prefer Christ above all. 14:26-27 (16:13)
- Hate (not sinful hatred)
 - Love Jesus more. Mt. 10:37 (Gen. 29:30f)
 - "If" Not with divided heart (*Jno. 12:42-43*)

Counting the Cost of Discipleship (Lk. 14:28-32)

- Two points of reference:
 - Relationships (family. brethren. life). 14:26
 - Responsibilities (bear your cross). *14:27* (*Gal. 6:5; Mt. 16:24*)
- PRICE TO PAY: Self-denial. sacrifice and service. *14:33*; *9:23*

Counting the Cost of Discipleship (Lk. 14:28-32)

- Jesus set this example. Mt. 26:38-44
 - Sacrifice. 26:39
 - Submission. *26:42*

John 10:17-18

- Steadfastness. 26:44
- Lifelong commitment. *Heb. 3:6, 14;* 10:36-39

Have You Counted the Cost of becoming a Christian?

- How to be saved (Mk. 16:15-16; Acts 2: 38-41; 17:30)
- Renounce past sins. Acts 19:18-20
- Humility before God and men. *Jms. 4:10*

Have You Counted the Cost of becoming a Christian?

- Objections include:
 - "I'll condemn my parents" (Lk. 16:27-30)
 - "I'll lose friends, business" (Acts 19:24-27)
- Different way of life. Rom. 12:1-2; Phil. 3:7-11 (1 Jno. 2:15)
- Different way of thinking. 2 Cor. 10:5
- You can pay the price! (1 Pet. 5:9)

Have You Counted the Cost of being Married?

- Its permanency. *Mt. 19:6; Rom. 7:2*
- Leaving and cleaving. Mt. 19:4-5
- Forsaking all others (fidelity). *Heb. 13:4*
- Serve. not "be served". *Eph. 5:22-25*
- Marry a Christian who has faith, godly values and the goal of heaven

Psalm 127:3-5

Have You Counted the Cost of having Children?

- Financial responsibility. 1 Tim. 5:8
- Time. Eph. 5:16; cf. Deut. 6:4ff
- Training. *Eph. 6:4; Tit. 2:4*
- Selfishness hinders good parenting!

1 Cor. 16:13-14

Have You Counted the Cost of Standing for the Truth?

- Loss of friends & even brethren. 2 Tim. 4:16
- Loss of reputation (among false brethren). 3 Jno. 9-12
- Cost Jesus his life!
- Cost the apostles much (1 Cor. 4:9-13)
- Does it cost us anything? (2 Tim. 3:12)

Revelation 2:10

Have You Counted the Cost of being Faithful unto Death?

- Context of persecution: even to the point of death (cf. Phil. 1:21)
- Conquer the fear of men. *Mt. 10:28; Heb.* 13:5-6
- Be watchful. 1 Pet. 5:8-9; Heb. 5:12-14; 6:9-12

Matthew 25:30

A Higher Price will be Paid if you do not Follow Jesus Now!

- Everlasting destruction. 2 Thess. 1:8-9
- Leaving all for Christ and His gospel will <u>bless</u> you and <u>challenge</u> you now – and finally <u>reward</u> you with <u>eternal life</u>. *Mk. 10:28-31*
