▶ Mark 4:24, “And he said to them, ‘Pay attention to what you **hear**: with the measure you use, it will be measured to you, and still more will be added to you.’”

▶ Be told or informed of:  
 “have you heard the news?”  
 “they heard that I had moved”  
 “no doubt you heard about the raid”

▶ Antonyms:

be unaware

▶ Mark 7:14, “And he called the people to him again and said to them, ‘**Hear** me, all of you, and understand”

▶ Luke 11:28, “But he said, ‘Blessed rather are those who **hear** the word of God and keep it!’”

► 1 Samuel 8:19-22, "**Nevertheless the people refused to obey the voice of Samuel**; and they said, Nay; but we will have a king over us; That we also may be like all the nations; and that our king may judge us, and go out before us, and fight our battles. And Samuel **heard all the words of the people**, and he rehearsed them in the ears of the LORD. And the LORD said to Samuel, **Hearken** unto their voice, and make them a king. And Samuel said unto the men of Israel, Go ye every man unto his city." (KJV)

► 1 Samuel 15:22-23, "And Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in **obeying the voice of the LORD**? Behold, **to obey is better than sacrifice**, and to hearken than the fat of rams. For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king."

► 1 Samuel 15:24-26, "And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: for I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and thy words: because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice. Now therefore, I pray thee, pardon my sin, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD. And Samuel said unto Saul, I will not return with thee: for **thou hast rejected the word of the LORD**, and the LORD hath rejected thee from being king over Israel." (KJV)

► Joshua 3:7-10, "And the LORD said unto Joshua, This day will I begin to magnify thee in the sight of all Israel, that they may know that, as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee. And thou shalt command the priests that bear the ark of the covenant, saying, When ye are come to the brink of the water of Jordan, ye shall stand still in Jordan. And Joshua said unto the children of Israel, Come hither, **and hear the words of the LORD your God**. And Joshua said, Hereby ye shall know that the living God is among you, and that he will without fail drive out from before you the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Hivites, and the Perizzites, and the Girgashites, and the Amorites, and the Jebusites."

► 1 Kings 9:3-5, "And the LORD said unto him, I have **heard** thy prayer and thy supplication, that thou hast made before me: I have hallowed this house, which thou hast built, to put my name there for ever; and mine eyes and mine heart shall be there perpetually. **And if thou wilt walk before me, as David thy father walked, in integrity of heart, and in uprightness, to do according to all that I have commanded thee, and wilt keep my statutes and my judgments**: Then I will establish the throne of thy kingdom upon Israel forever, as I promised to David thy father, saying, There shall not fail thee a man upon the throne of Israel." (KJV)

► 1 Kings 10:1-7, "And when the queen of Sheba **heard** of the fame of Solomon concerning the name of the LORD, she came to prove him with hard questions. And she came to Jerusalem with a very great train, with camels that bare spices, and very much gold, and precious stones: and when she was come to Solomon, she communed with him of all that was in her heart ..."

- ▶ Acts 5:29, "Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, **We ought to obey** God rather than men." (KJV)
- ▶ Romans 6:15-16, "What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid. Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves **servants to obey**, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?"

- ▶ Matthew 15:10-11 "And he called the multitude, and said unto them, Hear, and understand: Not that which goeth into the mouth defileth a man; but that which cometh out of the mouth, this defileth a man." (KJV)
- ▶ Matthew 17:5, "While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him." (KJV)
- ▶ Matthew 18:17, "And if he shall neglect to hear them, tell it unto the church: but if he neglect to hear the church, let him be unto thee as an heathen man and a publican."
