# Man Warned Against Drifting (ASV)

- Source of drifting.
  - Lack of understanding. Matthew 13:19
  - Cares of the world. Mt. 13:22; cf. Luke 14:15ff
  - Deceitfulness of riches. Matthew 13:22;
    1 Timothy 6:9-10
  - Tribulation or persecution. Matthew 13:20
  - Prejudice. Matthew 13:15
  - Love of the world. 1 John 2:15-17; James 4:4
  - Compromise. Galatians 1:10; 2:5
  - Lack of love for the truth. 2 Thessalonians 2:10-12

## Warning Reveals Two Truths

- "Word spoken through angels proved steadfast..." cf. Hebrews 1:1; 1 Peter 4:11; Acts 7:51-53
  - Fixed and settled.
- "Every transgression and disobedience received a just recompense of reward."
  - Hebrews 10:28ff; cf. Deuteronomy 17:2-7
  - 1 John 3:4; James 4:17
  - 2 Pet. 2:4-9; cf. 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9

#### We Must Listen!!! Heb. 2:3

- Truth came from Christ and is confirmed. Hebrews 2:3, Truth is revealed!
