
How Well Do You Listen?

Three Types Of Listeners

The "Dull Of Hearing" Hebrews 5:11f; cf. Matthew 13:13-15

-Understanding God's truth

- Turning from sin to God

- And being healed (saved) by God!

The Importance Of Good Listening

- ■Essential To Being Blessed ...
 - -There are wonderful things to learn.
 Matthew 13:15-18
 - -Some did not have the opportunity to learn. 1 Peter 1:10-12; Ephesians 1:3; 3:10-12

We miss out on these blessings if we do not carefully listen!

The Importance Of Good Listening

- Essential To Saving Faith
 - -Saved by grace through Christ Ephesians 2:8-9; Romans 5:1-2; cf. Romans 1:16-17
 - -Faith comes through hearing. cf. Romans 10:14,17; cf. John 20:30-31

Does your "listening" hinder the development of your faith?

The Importance Of Good Listening

- Essential To Bearing Fruit ...
 - Honest and good heart brings forth fruit.Luke 8:15
 - Bearing fruit comes from "understanding" the grace of God! cf. Colossians 1:6

Only by listening well can we "understand" God's grace, and be thus motivated to bear fruit to his glory!

The Importance Of Good Listening

- Essential To Preventing Apostasy ...
 - Danger of drifting, by neglect Hebrews2:1-3

Poor listening is often the first step to apostasy!

The Importance Of Good Listening

- Essential To Avoiding Rejection And Condemnation ...
- If we do not listen as we should
 - -We reject Christ. Matthew 10:14-15; 40
 - -We are judging ourselves unworthy of eternal life - cf. Acts 13:44-49; cf. Matthew 12:41-42
 - -Judged by God's word. John 12:48

-The rejection and condemnation will come from God!

Steps To Better Listening

■ Stop talking ... cf. James 1:19; cf. Nehemiah 8:3-5; Acts 20:7f
