Lost Religious Men Luke 18:9-14

Lost Religious Men

- 1. You can be <u>religious</u> and be <u>lost</u>! To avoid this, learn from religious people who were lost, and then apply the remedies to be saved.
 - Don't trust your religious tradition,Luke 3:7-9

- I. SAUL: ZEALOUS BUT STILL LOST Acts 22:3-4; Galatians 1:13-14
- A. Religious zeal without knowledge will not save you Acts 22:3; Galatians 1:14; Romans 10:1-3.
 - 1. Much learning, but not in truth (theological seminary; PhDs...).
 - 2. Religious training not enough to save!

- I. SAUL: ZEALOUS BUT STILL LOST Acts 22:3-4; Galatians 1:13-14
- B. A good conscience does not save, Acts 23:1.
 - 1. Thought he was serving God, Acts 26:9.
 - 2. An untaught conscience can deceive us in regards to salvation! 1 Timothy 1:13

- I. SAUL: ZEALOUS BUT STILL LOST Acts 22:3-4; Galatians 1:13-14
- C. <u>Remedy</u>: Apply zeal in the right direction, Acts 22:16; Philippians 3:4-8.
 - 1. When religiously zealous man learns truth, he must use his zeal to obey gospel, Romans 10:3.
 - 2. Baptized / wash away sins

- II. CORNELIUS: A MORAL MAN LOST Acts 10:1-2, 22; 11:14
- A. His outstanding moral character did not remove his sins.
 - 1. Moral purity can only save us if we never sin! Romans 3:23; 6:23
 - 2. God calls on us to be morally pure, Ephesians 5:3-11; 1 Peter 2:11-12.
 - 3. But, present morality does not forgive past sins.

II. CORNELIUS: A MORAL MAN LOST Acts 10:1-2, 22; 11:14

- B. <u>Remedy</u>: Combine proper obedience with moral life, Acts 10:43, 33-35, 48; 11:14, 18.
 - 1. Gospel will save the moral man through faith, **Acts 10:43** (11:14).
 - 2. Must repent and work right. (Acts 10:35) – Baptized (10:48), 11:18.
 - 3. Faith, repentance, and baptism.

III. PHARISEES: DECEIVED IN SELF-RIGHTEOUSNESS

Luke 18:9-14

- A. A warning against self-righteousness, Matthew 23:3-12.
 - 1. Don't exalt self over others, Luke 18:14 (Romans 12:16).
 - 2. Don't say but not do, Matthew 23:3 (Matthew 15:7-8).
 - 3. Don't bind men's traditions, Matthew 23:4 (Colossians 2:22-23)
 - 4. Don't act to be seen by men, Matthew 23:5 (Matthew 6:2-4).
 - 5. Don't seek honor from men, Matthew 23:6-10 (John. 12:42-43).

III. PHARISEES: DECEIVED IN SELF-RIGHTEOUSNESS Luke 18:9-14

- B. <u>Remedy</u>: **Humble** yourself before God and men, **Matthew 23:12** (**James 4:6-10**).
 - 1. God gives us the chance to humble ourselves; if we do not, God will humble us!
 Luke 18:14.
 - 2. Humble heart obeys the truth in order to become the kind of person God wants,
 Matthew 23:27-28.

CONCLUSION

- 1. We can be religious and be lost!
- 2. To be saved, we must have: <u>Zeal</u>, <u>morality</u>, and <u>full obedience</u> coupled with humility.
- 3. Only Jesus can save you, Acts 4:12 (H-B-R-C-B ... Saved). Be zealous and repent (Revelation 3:19); be faithful to Jesus (Revelation 2:10).
