"MAKE DISCIPLES"

- 1. In The Great Commission, Jesus stated,
 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations ...", <u>Matthew 28:19-20</u>
- 2. To "make disciples" is the GOAL of evangelizing the world for Christ
- 3. What does it means to be His disciple, and how does one become a disciple?

I. WHAT IS A DISCIPLE?

- A. THE WORD DISCIPLE
 - 1. The Greek word translated "disciple" is mathetes (math-ay-tace)
 - 2. It is used 261 times in the New Testament
 - 3. Literally means a learner, pupil
 - 4. It denotes "one who follows another's teaching" Vine
 - 5. A disciple was not only a learner, he was also an adherent

I. WHAT IS A DISCIPLE?

- **B. THE GOAL OF A DISCIPLE**
 - 1. To be like his or her teacher, <u>Luke 6:40</u>
 - 2. To be Jesus' disciple, then, is to strive to be like Him!
 - 3. This is the goal of God in the redemption of mankind, that we be conformed to the image of His Son, <u>Romans 8:29</u>

I. WHAT IS A DISCIPLE?

- C. THE MARKS OF A DISCIPLE
 - 1. Abides in the word of Christ, <u>John 8:31</u>;
 14: 23; 2 John 9
 - It requires one to be a doer of the Word, and not only a hearer, <u>Matthew 7:21-27;</u> <u>James 1:21-25</u>

I. WHAT IS A DISCIPLE?

- C. THE MARKS OF A DISCIPLE
 - 2. Loves the brethren, <u>John 13:34-35</u>; <u>1</u>
 <u>John 3:23</u>; <u>1 Thessalonians 4:9</u>; <u>1 Peter</u>
 1:22
 - 3. Bears much fruit, <u>John 15:8</u>; <u>Mark 4:20</u>;
 <u>Luke 8:15</u>; <u>Romans 7:4</u>
 - John and Jesus warned against not bearing fruit for God, <u>Matthew 3:10</u>; <u>John</u> <u>15:1-2</u>

II. THE COST OF DISCIPLESHIP

- A. JESUS MUST COME FIRST <u>Luke</u> 14:25-26; Matthew 6:33
 - 1. Before anyone else, including members of our own family – <u>Matthew 10:34-37</u>
 - 2. Even before one's self Luke 9:23-25

II. THE COST OF DISCIPLESHIP

- B. WILLING TO SUFFER FOR JESUS
 - 1. Taking up our own cross to follow Him Luke 14:27
 - 2. Trying to live godly lives in an ungodly world, we may find that following Christ sometimes involves ridicule and persecution – 2 Timothy 3:12

II. THE COST OF DISCIPLESHIP

- C. FORSAKING ALL TO FOLLOW JESUS
 - 1. Having counted the cost <u>Luke 14:28-</u>
 33
 - 2. Nothing can take precedence over Him and His Will for us

III. MAKING DISCIPLES

- A. God Calls the Lost with Gospel Teaching,
 John. 6:44-45; Romans 10:8-13, 14-17;
 2 Thessalonians 2:13-14
 - 1. Hear and learn from the Father by hearing the word of God

III. MAKING DISCIPLES

- B. Make Disciples by Gospel Preaching, Acts 2:14, 22, 36, 40
 - 1. Teach what must be done with the words commanded by God; the word of the gospel, <u>Acts 10:5-6, 22, 33</u>; <u>11:14</u>; <u>15:7</u>
 - 2. Preaching saves those who believe,
 1 Corinthians 1:21
 - 3. It is God's will that the gospel is preached, Acts 16:9-10

III. MAKING DISCIPLES

- C. Make Disciples by Baptizing Believers, <u>Matthew 28:19</u>
 - 1. Water Baptism is Essential:
 - a) For a relationship with God, <u>Matthew</u>28:19 (<u>Galatians 3:27</u>)
 - o b) For salvation, Mark. 16:16 (1 Peter 3:21)
 - o c) For remission of sins, Acts 2:38
 - o d) For cleansing, Acts 22:16
 - e) For new life in Christ, Romans 6:3-4
