What Jesus Sought And What He Seeks

- Of the fig tree Fruit.
 - Nature of fig trees: "On this kind of tree the fruit forms before the leaves and should be full grown before the leaves appear; so this tree, by putting on its foliage before the time for figs, was proclaiming itself superior to all other fig trees. This made it a striking symbol of the hypocrite, who, not content with appearing to be as good as other people, usually puts on the appearance of being a great deal better." (J.W. McGarvey)

What Jesus Sought And What He Seeks

- Of the Jewish nation Fruit.
 - He had a right to expect it because Jehovah had made Israel a "special people" unto Himself. Deuteronomy 7:6; Exodus 19:5-6; Deuteronomy 26:19
 - He had cared for and protected them. Genesis 12:1-3; Genesis 37-50
 - He had delivered them from bondage of Egypt. Exodus 12.
 - Brought them into the promised land. Joshua 3-4

What Jesus Sought And What He Seeks

- Of Christians today Fruit.
 - Spiritual Israel a special people. 1 Peter 2:5, 9
 - Branch to be fruitful. John 15:2-5
 - New Creation. 2 Corinthians 5:17; Romans 6:1-4; Ephesians 4:17-24; Titus 2:11-12; Colossians 3:1-2
 - The likeness and image of Christ. Philippians 2:5, 19-21; 1 Peter 2:21; Galatians 2:20 Colossians 3:10
 - Holy character. 1 Peter 1:14-15
 - Self denial. Matthew 16:24

In the fig tree – "Nothing but leaves."

What Christ Found And Finds

- In the Jewish Nation "Nothing but leaves."
 - John 6:14; 12:42-43 Lip service to his miracles.
 - Matthew 22 Captious questions.
 - Matthew 23:23-28 Outward expressions, hypocrisy.
 - Acts 7 Stubbornness & rejection.
 - Mark 15:12-14 "Crucify him..."

What Christ Found And Finds

- In Christians today "Nothing but leaves."
 - We profess to "speak where the Bible speaks." 1 Peter 4:11
 - Necessitates knowing how God speaks to us. Acts 15
 - Examples. Cain, Nadab & Abihu, King Uzziah, etc.
 - Necessitates study. Colossians 3:16; 2 Timothy 2:15; 1 Peter 3:15

What Christ Found And Finds

- In Christians today "Nothing but leaves."
 - We profess to worship.
 - Observe the Lord's Supper every Lord's day. Acts 20:7
 - Communion with the Lord. 1 Corinthians 10:16-17
 - Communion with other Christians. 1 Corinthians 11:17ff; Edify. 1 Corinthians 14:26
 - Need to assemble. Hebrews 10:24-25; Psalms 122:1
 - Sing! Teach & admonish. Ephesians 5:19
 - Need to talk to the Lord! Philippians 4:4-6; 1 Peter 5:6; Hebrews 4:14-16; 7:25; cf. Joshua 3:11-13



What Christ Found And Finds

- In Christians today "Nothing but leaves."
 - We teach forgiveness, but harbor ill will. Matthew 5:23; 18:15

Examples:

Joseph forgave his brothers – Genesis 45:5-15; 50:19,20. David forgave Saul – 1 Samuel 24:9-22. The prodigal son's father – Luke 15:20-24. The sinner in Corinth – 2 Corinthians 2:5-8.

What Christ Found And Finds

- In Christians today "Nothing but leaves."
 - We teach repentance, but often only regret. metanoia – "a change of mind for the better, heartily to AMEND with abhorrence of one's past sins." (<u>Thayer</u>, 405)
 - Acts 17:30-31; David Psalms 51. Luke 15 Prodigal Luke 22 Peter. Acts 9:9 Saul.
 - "It is easy to bring a man to the river of regret, but you cannot always make him drink of the water of repentance."

What Christ Did & Will Do

To the fig tree.

- Cursed it and it withered away forever.
- To the Jewish Nation.
 - Scattered to the four winds of the earth.
 cf. Joshua 3:14-16; 2 Kings 17-18; Jeremiah 25:8-11

To Christians.

Cut off. John 15:1-6
