• Thayer's Definition

• to walk, to make one's way, progress; to make due use of opportunities, Hebrew for; to live, to regulate one's life, to conduct one's self, to pass one's life

▶ "walk" is an action

▶ God says again and again how Christians must walk!

▶ Walking demonstrates a forward movement

▶ We WALK by the road map (the Standard)

▶ Our path is straight and well lit

▶ Our WALK is individual, with endurance, for a life time

• John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way (*hodos*), the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

- **HODOS** Number 3598
- 1) properly
 - a) a way
- 2) a traveled way, road
 - b) a travelers way, journey, traveling
- 2) metaphorically
 - a) a course of conduct
 - b) a way (i.e. manner) of thinking, feeling, deciding

- **hodos** - Acts 9:2, 19:23, 22:4, 24:14, 24:22. These citations reference one way, singular

- **Our walk is an action**
- **Our walk is forward**
- **Our walk is according to the Standard**
- **Our walk is straight and well lit**
- **Our walk is individual, with endurance for a life time**
- **Our walk is on one path only**
