Philippians 1:1 “Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus, to all the saints in Christ Jesus that are at Philippi, with the bishops and deacons”

The Office

- Uses of the word Elder:
- Denotes certain persons appointed in local churches to exercise spiritual oversight over its members.
Acts 14:23; 15:2,4,6,22,23
Acts 20:17
Acts 21:18
1 Timothy 5:17
Titus 1:5
1 Peter 5:1

The Office

- Uses of the word Elder:
- Elder, in the last sense, is used synonymously with bishop and pastor, referring to the same office and work. Ephesians 4:11 (*poimen*); 1 Peter 5:2 (tend); Acts 20:17, 28 (feed)

The Office

- The responsibility and work of an Elder.
 - To feed the church. Acts 20:28
 - To guard the flock from false teachers. Acts 20:29-31.
 - To rule the church. cf. Romans 12:8; 1 Timothy 5:17
 - Not as lording it over, but as examples. 1 Peter 5:3
 - To tend the flock, *“exercising the oversight thereof”* 1 Peter 5:2
 - *“Watching in behalf of souls”* Hebrews 13:17
