 - ×Selected to care for Grecian widows.
 - Acts 6:1ff
 - ×Able to preach. Acts 6:10
 - ×Accused, Acts 6:11

PAUL PRAYED AT HIS DEATH

- * 2 Tim 4:16 "All forsook me: may it not be laid to their account."
- * Who was Paul (Saul)?
 - + Present at the stoning of Stephen. Cf. Acts 7-8
 - + Persecuted Christians. Believed Jesus an imposter. 26:9-12; 22:19-21
 - + Saul's conversion. Acts 9:20-22; cf. ch.22,26
 - + Paul the persecuted. 2 Cor. 11:23; 4:7-10; 16-18; Rom. 8:18; 2 Tim 4:16

PAUL PRAYED AT HIS DEATH

 - During his former imprisonment at Rome Timothy was with him. Phil 1:1,7
 - * Paul was not afraid to die. Acts 21:13; 25:11; Phil. 1:21; cf. 2 Tim. 4:6-8
 - w Where did Paul learn how a Christian should live and die? (Saw Stephen!)

FORGIVENESS IS CONDITIONAL

- ★ One must repent. Luke 17:3; 13:3;

- * One must obey. Rom. 2:8-9; 2 Thess. 1:7ff; Heb. 5:8-9
- * Forgiveness is "in Christ." Eph. 1:3-7; cf. Gal. 3:26-27: 1 Cor. 12:12
