Bible Baptism

• <u>Baptize (baptizo)</u>: "dip, submerge, immerse"

"...used among the Greeks to signify the dyeing of a garment, or the drawing of water by dipping a vessel into another..." (<u>Vine</u>)

- Requires "much water" Jno. 3:23
- A burial Col. 2:12
- Going down into & coming up out of water – Acts 8:38-39

Its Purpose and Design

Design of Water Baptism Regarding Sin & Salvation

- For remission of sins, Acts 2:38 (Mk. 16:16)
 - Release from punishment due sin, 1 Jno. 3:4; Rom. 6:23
 - "Forgiveness of, cleansing from, salvation from, blotting out of, washing away, no more remembering of..."
 - Release from effect of one's past sins, Acts 2:38; Acts 8:12-13 (18-24)

Objection: In Acts 2:38, "eis" means "because of" not "in order to"

• Matthew 26:28 "this is My blood... which is shed for many for the remission of sins"

Acts 2:38 Repent, and...be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ "for the remission of sins"

IN ORDER TO HAVE IN ORDER TO HAVE

Design of Water Baptism Regarding Sin & Salvation

- <u>Turning point from sin to salvation</u>, Acts 2:38; 3:19 (22:16)
 - Turn again, "be converted," *Acts 3:19 (9:35; 11:21)*
 - Action of obedient faith, *Jms. 2:18, 24*
 - Sinner's obedient response to the gospel, *Acts 2:40*
 - Thessalonians, 1 Thess. 1:9 (Acts 17:4; 2:40-41)



Design of Water Baptism Regarding Sinner & Christ

- <u>Baptized into death of Christ</u>, *Rom. 6:3* Obtain the benefits of His death
- *Rom. 5:8-10* By His blood we are...
 Justified
 - Saved from wrath
 - Reconciled to God

Design of Water Baptism Regarding The Sinner

Baptize those who have died to sin, *Rom. 6:4-7*

Body of sin is done away, *6:6-7 (Col. 2: 11-12)*

- Dead to sin & alive unto God (6:11)
 - ■When we *"died with Christ" (6:8)*
 - ■When "baptized into death" (6:4-5)
- Newness of life after baptism, (6:4)

Design of Water Baptism Regarding The Sinner

An appeal of a good conscience toward God, 1 Pet. 3:21

- Answer, appeal to God for salvation
 - Blood cleanses conscience, *Heb. 9:14*
 - Blood contacted in baptism, *Rom. 6:3*
 - Boldly enter God's presence, *Heb. 10:19, 22*
- Without baptism the appeal to come before God & be saved is denied!

Design of Water Baptism Regarding The Church

- Baptized into one body, the church, 1 Cor. 12:12-13
 - Added together, *Acts 2:41*
 - Added by the Lord, *Acts* 2:47
 - Added by obeying the Spirit's command to be baptized, *1 Cor. 12:12-13*
