### What Shall I Render To The Lord?

Though David's life was filled with times of trouble, grief, and disappointment, he never forgot all that God had done for him.

Psalms 103:2-5 Psalms 40:5

# David then pondered the **responsibility** that he bore to God ...

Psalms 116:12

"What shall I <u>render</u> to the LORD, <u>for all</u> <u>His benefits</u> toward me?"

Render: to turn back, return to starting point, give back, relinquish, give in payment.2 Chronicles 32:25; Matthew 22:21

#### Psalms 116:13-19 – David's answer:

- Lift up the cup of salvation honor to God for His salvation.
- Call on the name of the Lord Acts 22:16
- Pay my vows in the presence of all His people do what we commit to. Ecclesiastes 5:4
- Precious is the death of His saints focus on the life to come. Philippians 1:21ff
- •I am your servant Luke 1:38
- Offer the sacrifice of thanksgiving Philippians 4:6
- Praise the Lord Psalms 145:1-3

What can we render to the Lord for all that He has done for us?

A far different perspective than what (else) can I get out of it?

Religion has somehow been transformed from returning back to God to "what else can God do for me?"

## What Shall We Render To The Lord?

# We can render acceptable and reverent worship to Him.

- David was glad to have the opportunity to go to the Lord's house and offer praise and worship unto Him (Psalms 122:1).
- •We also can, and should, <u>look forward</u> <u>and make adequate preparations</u> to assemble with the saints and offer worship that is *"in spirit and in truth"* (John 4:24) at every opportunity.
- •It should never be a burden (1 John 5:3) to set aside time in our life to "*turn back to give glory to God*" (Luke 17:18).

### We can render our thanksgiving ...

- •Good parents teach their children to say thank you ...
- •A lack of thanksgiving is the first step towards apostasy. Romans 1:20-21
- •It's a way of life. Hebrews 13:15
- •It's God's will. 1 Thessalonians 5:18
- •Context. 1 Thessalonians 5:18

#### We can render our love ...

- •Serving out of more than just duty (Luke 17:10) and fear (1 John 4:18).
- •1 John 4:7-12 He started it!
- •What does this passage invite us to do?

# We can render our talents and abilities for His sake.

- •We *all* have talents and abilities ... •Matthew 25:14ff
- •Two dangers
  - •Overestimate our talents •Underestimate our talents
- •Be useful ... 2 Timothy 2:21.
- •Bear fruit, be a positive influence and shed light. John 15:5, 8, 16; Matthew 5:13-16

# We can fulfill our commitment to Him.

- •Note the context of Psalms 116:12ff •We can fulfill our commitment to the Lord ... to the end. cf. Revelation 2:10
- •Fulfill our commitment that Jesus is our Lord. Luke 6:46
- •Without making excuses. Luke 14:15-24

## We can share with others the good news of what God has done for us.

- "It'll cost you" Do for others what others have done for you. 2 Timothy 2:2
- •Practice Study Teach. Ezra 7:10
- "We are not doing right. This day is a day of good news, but we are keeping silent; if we wait until morning light, punishment will overtake us." 2 Kings 7:3-15 (verse 9)

### We can give of our time.

- •The command is to spend it wisely! Ephesians 5:15-17
- •How many hours in your day?
- •Does God like leftovers? Malachi 1:8-13, *"Should I receive that from your hand?"*

### We can give of our blessings.

- •As with our time, do we put first things first?
- •The law of first fruits.
- •All things are His. James 1:17
- •Giving some back ....
- •1 Corinthians 16:1-2; 2 Corinthians 8:1-6; 9:6-8

#### We Can, And Must, Give God First Place!!!

"... seek first His kingdom and His righteousness ..." •Matthew 6:33 But beyond anything else, God desires most of all is that we render our own self to Him.

 What must we render before anything else?

- •2 Corinthians 8:5, "... they first gave themselves to the Lord ..."
- •A "transformed" life. (Mark 12:30; Romans 12:1-2)
  - Present Imperative Continuous and repeated action.
